In 1994, he was elected the first president of a democratic South Africa.

Mandela and the South African president F. W. de Klerk won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1993 for their work to end racial segregation. In November 2009, The United Nations General Assembly declared 18 July Nelson Mandela International Day. Every year, Mandela's day celebrates the idea that each individual has the power to transform the world, the ability to make an impact.

In 2004, Mandela retired from public life. Mandela was a charming, charismatic person with a passion for boxing. He was married three times and had six children. He died on 5 December 2013 at the age of 95. He had an official State Funeral where leaders from all over the world were present. Today, Nelson Mandela is considered an international symbol for his life effort to end racial prejudice and injustice.
